INTRODUCTION

- A. The Parties entered into a funding agreement dated 1 August 2011 ("the Supplemental Funding Agreement") which is supplemental to the master funding agreement (the "Master Agreement") made between the same parties and dated 1 August 2011 relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of an independent school known as Djanogly Northgate Academy.
- B. The Parties subsequently varied and amended the terms of the Supplemental Funding Agreement by a Deed of Variation on 12 September 2014.
- C. The Parties now wish to further vary and amend the terms of the Supplemental Funding Agreement and wish to record their agreement as to such variations/amendments to the Supplemental Funding Agreement by this Deed.

LEGAL AGREEMENT
